TO: Parent/guardian of an enrolling 6th grade student or
any student new to Woodford County schools

The Kentucky Department of Education requires the following student health information for your child's entry into 6th grade:

- ~ Tetanus/diphtheria (Td) immunization booster at 11-12 years of age if at least five years have passed since the last shot. **This is required of all entering 6th grade students, even if the Immunization Certificate has not expired.**
- ~ Second Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) immunization booster
- ~ Hepatitis B immunization series
- ~ School physical exam. **This must be recorded on the Kentucky Department of Education (6th grade) Form.** This is separate from the athletic physical required for sporting activities.

All immunizations should be up-do-date and listed on a Kentucky Immunization certificate with a valid expiration date. **This certificate will be required to be in the Middle School office before the start of the school year for your child to receive his/her schedule at the Tiger Bash and to start school.**

The Woodford County School System must abide by state regulations for current student health records. Please plan carefully for your child's entry into the sixth grade. We encourage you to schedule appointments early and turn in or mail the required immunization certificates and school physical form to the Woodford County Middle School office, 100 School House Road, Versailles, Kentucky 40383.
