Attendance Report – WCMS attendance for month 6 (Jan. 15-Feb. 15) is 94.98%.

Committee Reports

Budget – Draft of March 7 minutes were distributed.

CSIP Committee – Mrs. Koontz noted that the committee did meet and discussed the Achievement gaps in each area. Departments were to revise their goals and objectives after reviewing the strategies and their impact. A revised action component page is due by April 1st.

Technology Committee - Approved minutes of January 10 were distributed.

Curriculum Committee met and proposed a change in the current Advanced Placement policy (16.1-16.3) regarding the requirement of students to maintain a “B” average in those advanced classes. The recommended change was that students should receive no lower than a “C” average in an advanced class. Mrs. Powell made a motion to approve the change to Policies 16.1-16.3; seconded by Mrs. Owen. The 2nd reading of these policies will be on the April agenda.

Southern Association Quality Review

Mrs. Koontz reviewed the summation of all standards and how WCMS fulfilled those standards.

Senate Bill 168 (Identify gaps and develop a plan to close those gaps)

In 2004, the district decided to report gaps as percentages. However data is given as index scores, not percentage. As a result, in 2005 the SBDM decided to mark gaps as index points. Gaps have not been reduced significantly. Mrs. Koontz reviewed her Gap Target recommendations to reach the 2014 target of 100. Mrs. Holloway made a motion to approve the gap target recommendations; Mrs. Powell seconded. These recommendations will now be forwarded to the Woodford County Board of Education.

SBDM Council By-Laws

Ms. Poindexter (WCMS) is willing to serve as minority teacher representative. Sample teacher ballot was reviewed.

Executive Session

Mrs. Holloway made a motion to go into executive session; seconded by Mrs. Owen. Mrs. Holloway made a motion to come out of executive session; seconded by Ms.Campbell.
