**POLICY STATEMENT**

Grades for each class are calculated on a nine-week basis. Teachers may elect to assign a point value to each assignment (i.e. quiz = 20 points) or assign percentages to specific types of assignments (i.e. *all* quizzes together = 20% of total grade.) A student's grade for the nine-week average is calculated based on the percentage of work that was done. The student's average is compared to the percentile range in the grading scale and a letter grade is assigned.

**Grading Scale**

92 - 100 = A  
83 - 91 = B  
74 - 82 = C  
64 - 73 = D  
0 - 64 = F

To calculate a student's *final/semester grade*, the letter grade the student earned is assigned a point value.

A = 4          B = 3          C = 2          D = 1          F = 0

Core Classes (Math, Reading/Language Arts, Social Studies, Science, Writing)  
A student must earn a **minimum of 4 points in order to pass the class for the year.**

Semester Classes (Rotation classes, Government/Economics, Arts/Humanities or other semester classes)  
A student must earn a **minimum of 2 points per class per semester in order to pass the class.**

Scores that range in the 0.5 – 0.9 shall *not* be rounded.
