POLICY STATEMENT

Mission Statement:

Socialization for
All students to
Include all skill levels through
Learning, Leisure, and Leadership

Philosophy:

- Teach participants sportsmanship (helping students understand that sometimes you win and sometimes you lose and both are acceptable)
- Learning through experience
- Creating an open opportunity for ALL students
- Encouraging teamwork, leadership, and respect for others
- Learning new leisure time activities

- Opportunity for lifelong learning activities

Eligibility:

- Grades:
 - Any student who has earned 2 or more F's in classes three times during grade checks will not be permitted to participate in that ASA.
 - Grade checks will occur each time students are participating in a "qualifying event" (i.e., competitions, tournaments, presentations where students represent WCMS in the community).
- Behavior:
 - Students who receive 3 separate in-school or out-of-school suspensions will not be permitted to participate in their current ASA.
 - Students may be dismissed from an ASA by the club sponsor after consultation with WCMS administration.
- Attendance:
 - Once a student has missed 3 ASA sessions, the sponsor may choose to dismiss the student from participation in that ASA.
