

Woodford County Middle School
PTO Executive Committee Meeting
October 6, 2008

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by President Janine Coy-Geeslin at 6:35 p.m. in the WCMS library. Janine distributed an agenda (Attachment #1).

Officers Present: Janine Coy-Geeslin, Martha Gay, Debbie Hall, Laurel Kratt and Dawn Powers. Ms. Koontz and Ms. Hamilton also were present. Ms. Poindexter and Ms. Finney also attended part of the meeting. There was a quorum present.

Teacher Requests: Ms. Hamilton presented a request on behalf of the physical education, health and vocational studies teachers for the Practical Living Classroom Project. She explained that students would have checking accounts and would earn money for good behavior. Students then would be given the opportunity to purchase items at a silent auction. She asked for donations for the silent auction. Dawn Powers stated that she would send an e-mail to volunteers to request donations and that she would ask Ms. Timperman to put a donation request on the daily school e-mail.

September 15, 2008 Minutes: The minutes from the September 15, 2008 Executive Board Meeting were distributed and reviewed. Laurel Kratt made a motion to approve the minutes as corrected. The motion was seconded and passed.

Big Brothers/Big Sisters Program: Ms. Koontz explained that WCMS is teaming up with at-risk students through the Big Brother/Big Sister program and that applications may be obtained from her or Ms. Finney.

WCMS PTO 2008-2009 Budget: There was discussion regarding whether the WCMS PTO budget should be included on the PTO website. By general consensus, it was decided to include a general narrative of what PTO's money is used for on the website. Debbie Hall distributed a WCMS PTO 2008-2009 Approved Budget (Attachment # 2).

Volunteers for the Office: There was discussion regarding who can coordinate volunteers to work in the front office.

Additional Teacher Requests: Janine Coy-Geeslin read a thank you note from Ms. Finney for PTO's funding of the purchase of Jr. Scholastic magazines. Ms. Finney explained that the expenses for the Kentucky Youth Assembly in December have increased. There was discussion regarding the amount that PTO should give for this request and it was decided to make a decision at the November 3, 2008 Executive Board meeting.

Adjournment: Laurel Kratt made a motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded and the meeting was adjourned at 7:17 p.m.
